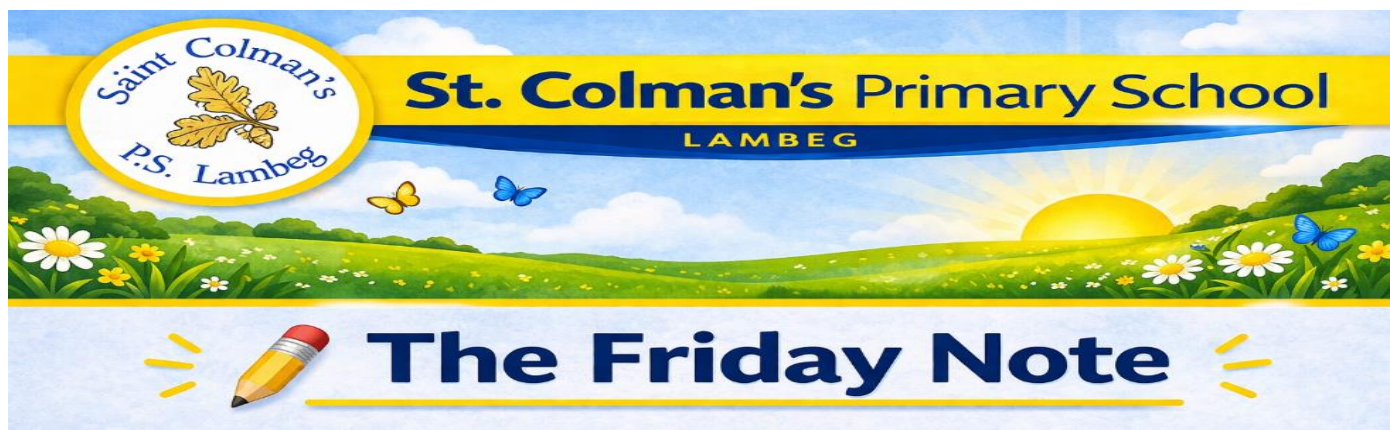




Friday 19th June 2026
